FAIR PROCESSING NOTICE

This notice tells you what information North View Housing Association (NVHA) collects and uses when handling your complaint.

The categories of personal information that we collect, process, retain, and share are:

- your name, address, telephone number and email address; and
- specific details regarding your complaint and how you want us to resolve your complaint (if you inform us of this).

We collect this personal information to:

- enable us to investigate your complaint in accordance with our Complaints Handling Procedure and the Scottish Public Services Ombudsman Act 2002;
- communicate with you in relation to your complaint;
- provide a response and agreed appropriate actions; and
- learn from your complaint in order to improve service delivery.

The lawful basis for collecting and using this information is that the complaints arise from the statutory functions imposed on NVHA by legislation.

We keep the personal information that we hold and use about you for no longer than we need to meet any legal, accounting, reporting or regulatory requirements.

We may share details of your complaint with:

- a member(s) of staff, if your complaint is about them;
- an independent complaint investigator (if your complaint is about The Director for example);
- our Management Committee;
- the SPSO, if you apply to the SPSO in relation to your complaint; and
- our advisers, auditors, consultants, solicitors and IT service providers.

We may need to transfer or store your personal information at locations outside the UK for the above purposes. We will comply with data protection law in relation to such transfer or storage by putting in place appropriate arrangements to protect your personal information.
